Aloha, Hawaii!

Hawaii has proven itself to be a rather unique addition to the United States. With eight main islands and more than 120 smaller islands, the Aloha State is the world's longest archipelago, spanning more than 10 degrees in latitude and a distance of 1,500 miles. Hawaii was initially annexed on July 7, 1898, at the request of President William McKinley, aiding America's quest to become a Pacific power as it extended U.S. territory well into the Pacific Ocean. Hawaii was named a territory in 1900, and it was governed by Sanford B. Dole, who formerly presided over the Provisional Government of Hawaii. Hawaii finally became a state in 1959, separated from the mainland U.S. by 2,500 miles and two time zones. Home to some of the most rare and exotic plants in the world, Hawaii is unlike any other state.

Income Tax: Withheld

The Tax Payment Act of 1943, also known as the Revenue Act, was passed by Congress on July 1 during World War II. Increased taxes due to the war made it difficult for many Americans to save for income tax when tax time was due in the spring. The solution? Employers would withhold workers' federal income taxes and pay them directly to the Internal Revenue Services. Withholding wages from workers would ensure the government getting their taxes on time.

It is interesting to note that the Revenue Act is said to be the first revenue act to be vetoed by the President. President Roosevelt rejected the bill by arguing it was a "tax relief bill providing relief not for the needy but for the greedy." Senate Majority Leader, Alben Barkley of Kentucky, in protest, resigned and called the president's comment "a calculated and deliberate assault upon the legislative integrity of every member of Congress." The Senate overrode the presidential veto by a vote of 72 to 14.

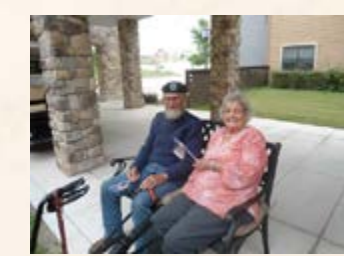

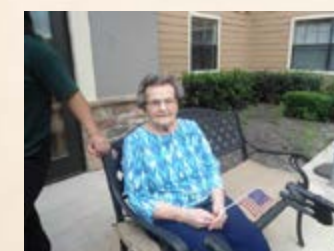

History Revisited

On July 4th, the Liberty Bell Rang for American Independence – or Did It?

It's a famous scene. A young boy with blond hair and blue eyes was supposed to have been posted in the street next to Independence Hall to give a signal to an old man in the bell tower when independence was declared.

It never happened. The story was made up by writer George Lippard in a book intended for children. There was no pretense that the story was genuine.

If the Liberty Bell rang at all in celebration of independence, nobody took note at the time. The bell was not even named in honor of American independence.

As for the famous crack, it was a badly designed bell and it cracked. End of story. The Liberty Bell can be viewed in all of its glory in Philadelphia, where it is displayed in a glass chamber in the appropriately named Liberty Bell Center on Market Street.

Independence Day

Independence Day, or the Fourth of July, celebrates the adoption of the Declaration of Independence by the 13 colonies in 1776, thereby severing their ties to Great Britain.

That historic document was drafted by Thomas Jefferson, with substantial edits made by other members of the Congress. An officially inscribed version was signed by 56 members of the Continental Congress on August 2.

Celebration of the day began during the American Revolution with fireworks and parades, traditions that continue today. The best-known observance takes place in Washington, D.C., and includes a spectacular fireworks display.

Did you know?

- A salute of one gun for each state in the United States, called a "salute to the union," is fired on Independence Day at noon by any capable military base.
- The first week of July is one of the busiest American travel periods of the year, as many people utilize the holiday for longer vacation trips.
